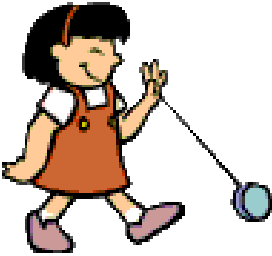

Some children walk to school.



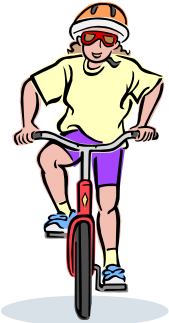
Some people come by bus

Miss Norquoy is our Depute Head Teacher.

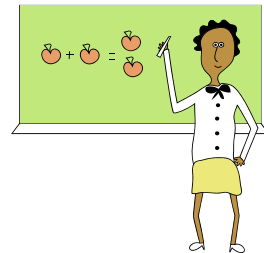

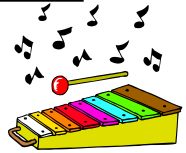
Our own teacher helps us in the classroom.

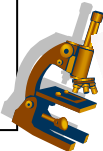

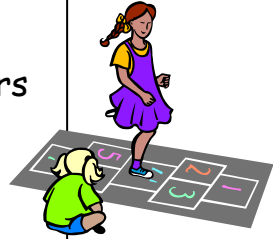
Playtime

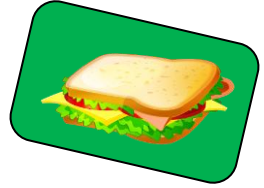
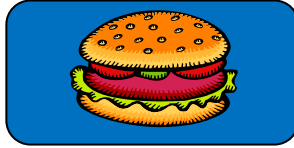
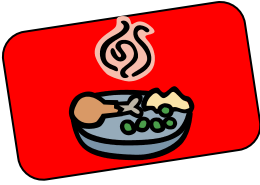
Lunchtime

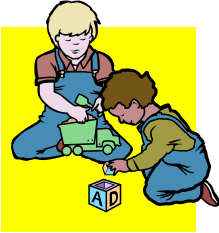

Every summer we have a sports day when we win points for our House.

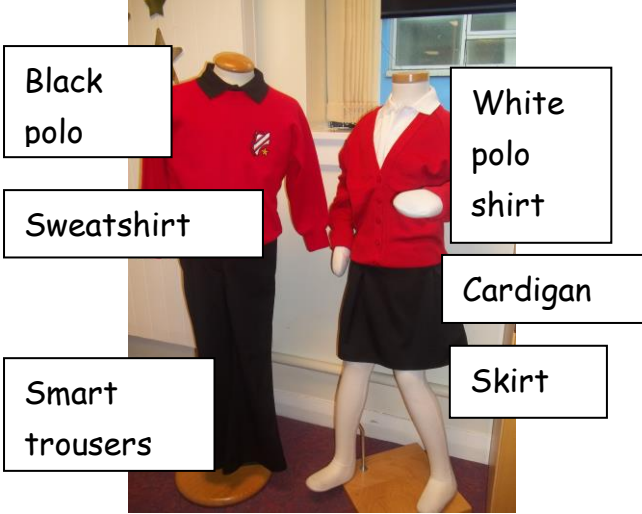


Our parents come to meet our teachers at Parents' Night to find out how well we have been
