School Bus Service

The network of school bus services can also be used by pupils not entitled to free school travel.

This service allows pupils who are not entitled to free school transport to pay a fare/use 10 Journey tickets.

Primary school pupils

<u>Free School Bus Passes</u> are available for those living at least 1.5 miles from school. Otherwise a standard fare of 75p per single journey is charged. There are however ways to save money:

 Ten journey tickets for £5.68 - used for any ten journeys to or from school or a £1.28 return can be paid on the bus.

Ten journey tickets can be obtained from Council Information Offices, or some schools.

All school contract buses for primary pupils are equipped with seat belts for the safety and comfort of pupils. However, parents must note that it is the responsibility of the child to ensure that the belt is worn - drivers are not expected to leave the cab to assist in securing the belt.

In addition to the main services a number of minibus/taxi services also run to farms and small communities, whilst conventional service buses - with pupils paying fares - may be used for some journeys to and from school. Please contact the Public Transport Unit for further information.
