Numeracy & Maths

In Numeracy, we will be focusing on revision and consolidation of the strategies-Review, Revisit and Revise. We will also be doing some numeracy using calculators and looking at word problems and numeracy in real life contexts. Mrs Welsh will teach Maths to both classes and will cover Data Handling, and revise Time duration.

Miss Craig will continue to teach problem solving to both classes and we will focus on applying Maths to practical challenges and using visual models to prove solutions.

Literacy & English

We will look at some traditional Brazilian folklore stories. Then we will move on to discussion and procedure texts. Children will produce writing in both hand written texts and typed/ digital media

<u>Languages</u>

Mrs Welsh will teach Spanish to both classes this term As part of our Rio topic we will introduce some Portuguese too.

Health & Wellbeing

In PE, we will be doing dance, cross country running, athletics and rounders.

We will have a weekly lesson to become more able in organising online and offline folders and files, using more desk top publishing features, and other features within office 365.

This Term we will be starting with a Rio de Janeiro topic, and thinking about the contrasts with our local environment.

After this, Primary 6 will be encouraged to take the lead to present a lesson/s on a subject of their choosing. They will have the opportunity to research that topic in class time but should practice their presentations at home

There will be more opportunities to develop leadership skills with the buddies too.
