## Welcome Back

We hope you had a great half Term. This is what we will be covering in Primary 6 in Term 2

### Numeracy & Maths

This term our focus for Numeracy will be Fractions, Decimals and Percentages. We will be applying our knowledge of multiplication and division.

For Mathematics, we are focusing on using, applying and identifying different units of measurement.

We will be continuing to apply and use strategies to complete problem solving activities.



### Literacy & English

In our Literacy, we will be exploring different genres linked with our World War 2 topic.

In writing, we will be exploring poetry and narratives. Through these we will be discussing different writing styles and use of metaphors and similes to create powerful and imaginative poems based on World War 2.

Grammar and punctuation lessons will also be used to develop writing skills when we will be focusing on sentence structure, using speech marks and grammatical features such as synonyms, adjectives, metaphors and alliteration to improve our descriptive writing.

We will continue to use cursive handwriting during handwriting lessons and in our everyday writing.



### Interdisciplinary Learning

Our second theme for this year is World War 2. We are going to be looking at what caused the war and identify key moments of history throughout. We will be learning poems about the war and will be creating lots of different styles of art through this topic. We will also be looking at specific ICT skills this term.

We will be taking part in an enterprise project, creating an item to sell at the Christmas Fayre!

### Health & Wellbeing



Classes will have PE on a Tuesday (outdoor) and Thursday (indoor). On a Thursday we will be doing dance in the hall and on a Tuesday we will be doing football outside.

P.E will be taking place outdoors (rain or shine!) so please ensure your child is wearing an appropriate P.E kit on these days.

In class, we will be using our school JIGSAW resource to focus on the year ahead, setting goals and discussing our aspirations. We will also be focusing on our responsibilities as citizens and what this means.

We will also be exploring zones of regulation and how we can use these in our daily lives.
