Welcome back Primary 5. We hope you had a lovely winter break. This is what we will be doing in Term 3.



<u>Numeracy & Maths</u>

In Maths we will be learning about shape, position and movement. We will be exploring properties of different shapes, symmetry and rotation.


In Numeracy, we will begin this term by developing our understanding of number further, looking at negative numbers. We then begin to look at fractions, decimals and percentages. We will use a mixture of ICT and games as well as written tasks to show our learning. Home learning tasks will reflect this throughout term 3. We highly encourage children to continue practising their times tables at home to support their learning in school.

<u>Health & Wellbeing</u>

In Health and Wellbeing, we will be exploring our own personal dreams and goals. We will then move onto our relationships topic, exploring different types of relationships we have with different people. We will also

be looking at memories of people we no longer see, as well as relationships with pets, touching on the issue of animal rights.

In PE we will start the term by learning the skills of Handball, and taking part in an Armadale cluster tournament. We will then use these skills to apply them to netball, and we will also work on our racket skills.



In Reading, we will be focusing on answering different types of questions about a text- both literal and inferential. We will also be making and organising notes using information linked to our topic.

In Writing, we will be looking at using Scot's vocabulary and including this in poems and fairy tales. We will then explore the features of explanation and exposition texts. For each of these genres we will be using our creative skills to create our own texts.

In Grammar, we will be focusing on incorporating adverbs, prefixes and suffixes as well as regular and irregular verbs. We will also be including dictation into our timetable this term which will help the children build on their knowledge of using correct punctuation such as capital letters, full stops and speech marks. This also links into our listening and talking skills.

Interdisciplinary Learning

We are so excited to be starting to prepare our P5 - 7 show this term! We are in the early stages of planning this, looking at different themes, thinking about scripts and songs. This will form our topic for this term, where we will look in detail at a specific musical and how this links to the theme of being unique. We will be making props, preparing costumes and creating backdrops, all whilst working on our IT and presentation skills. We can't wait to share our learning with you all on the 18th March!
