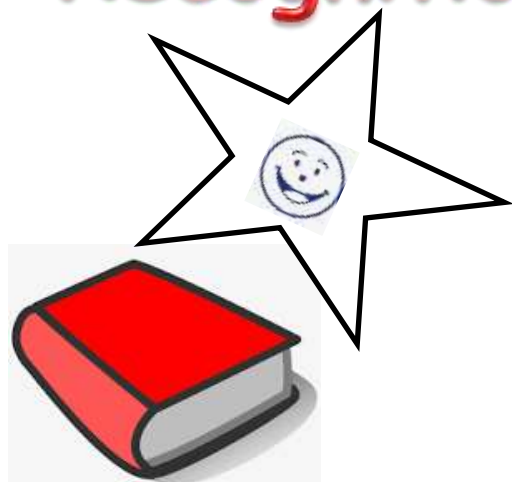


Article 31

READY RESPECTFUL RESPONSIBLE & SAFE ?

Actions and consequences agreed with our pupils, parents and staff

Article 12 states that children have the right to have a say in matters that affect them. We asked our children what they thought low, medium and high levels of behaviour look like and agreed on the consequences of these from our pupils, parents and staff.

Low level

1. Telling a lie
2. Arguing with a friend
3. Talking over teacher
4. Being too noisy when working
5. Not listening to instructions

Medium level

1. Low level persists
2. Name calling
3. Mocking someone
4. Leaving people out
5. Talking back to an adult

High level

1. Medium level persists
2. Offensive language
3. Intentional physical violence
4. Damaging property
5. Throwing objects
6. Bullying
7. Misbehaving with a device

Class

1. Verbal warning
2. Highlight consequence
3. Noted in behaviour book for parents to see and sign. Pupil will not earn reward time (-5 mins)
4. Red card - removal from room & parents phoned
5. Resolution (out with class)

Playground

1. PSW to inform class teacher after breaks/lunches
2. Disrespectful behaviour - Walking with an adult SLT or PSW for break and lunch for a whole week & loss of reward time(-5 mins)
3. As above and parents contacted by staff member at appropriate time
