Numeracy & Maths

This term we will continue to develop our understanding of place value, addition and subtraction, skip counting, money and number patterns. We will also be applying all of our previous skills. During Maths time, Mrs Davidson will be focusing on days of the week, months of the year and telling o'clock times.



Health & Wellbeing

In P.E., we will be learning some basic athletics and gymnastic skills. We will also be taking part in a block of ball skills and games. In Health, our new JIGSAW focus will be all about Being Healthy. This will look into healthy/unhealthy foods and the benefits of exercise, as well as supporting good mental health.

Literacy & English



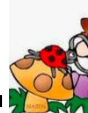
This term our literacy will continue to be developed through our class topics to make it more fun and relevant for the children. We will be learning about animals, and exploring life cycles. Our main focusses will be: talking about our ideas and giving reasons for our opinions, reading and writing words with consonant blends (e.g bl, st, nd), recognising and using features of non-fiction, using capital letters when writing stories and continuing to learn Tricky Words such as 'they', 'there' and 'said'.

We will be continuing fortnightly Home Learning using our Seesaw app.

Please continue to hear your child's reading at least twice a week.

Interdisciplinary Learning

- This term we will be investigating signs of Spring and life cycles, and looking after the environment as part of our Science topic. We will then be learning about 'All creatures great and small' as part of our animals topic, and we look forward to sharing our learning with you in our first class assembly in May. Look out for some special trips this term too – details to follow.
